### Science museum trip.

On Monday, Year 5 visited the National Science and Media Museum. Our topic this half term is Space, during our visit we watched a 3D film on the giant IMAX cinema screen all about the ISS (International Space Station) it was fascinating and we learnt a lot, that we will now use in our writing about How to Survive in Space. We also took part in a workshop 'Exploring Space' where we discovered how the use of telescopes, satellites and rockets help explore our universe and what chemistry and colour can tell us about distant planets and stars.
